



RESOLUTION

Keep the Nine Amendment

WHEREAS an independent United States Supreme Court is an essential element of America's system of checks and balances that protects our Constitutional rights.

WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has been composed of nine Justices for more than 150 years and,

WHEREAS the United States President and Congress should be prohibited from undermining the independence of the Supreme Court by changing the number of Justices on the Court.

Be It RESOLVED that the Idaho Federation of Republican Women join the National Federation of Republican Women and Republican National Committee to urge Congress to adopt the "Keep Nine Amendment" to the U.S. Constitution that states: "The Supreme Court of the United States shall be composed of nine Justices" and,

Be It RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to each elected local, state and federal representative in Idaho.

Be It RESOLVED that the Idaho Federation of Republican Women voted at its Biennial Convention in Caldwell, Idaho to support the "Keep Nine Amendment."
